

ATTORNEY REGISTRATION AND DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION of the SUPREME COURT OF ILLINOIS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In the exercise of the general administrative and supervisory authority over the Illinois Attorney and Registration and Disciplinary Commission, and consistent with Illinois Supreme Court Rule 45 and the Court's policy to allow and encourage the broad use of remote court appearances whenever possible and practicable,

It is hereby ordered:

- 1. The Commission order entered on May 26, 2021, is superseded by this order;
- 2. Effective May 1, 2023:
 - A. All uncontested hearings before the Hearing Board, including prehearing conferences, default hearings and consent hearings, shall be conducted remotely. An uncontested hearing may be held in person if there is good cause shown for doing so.
 - B. All contested hearings before the Hearing Board shall be held in person. A contested hearing may be held remotely if the Chair of the case and both parties agree to holding the hearing remotely.
 - C. All oral arguments before the Review Board shall be held in person. An oral argument may be held remotely if the Chair of the Review Board and both parties agree to holding the oral argument remotely.
- 3. This order remains in full force and effect until further order of the Commission.
